

**Lime Academy Hornbeam  
Site works 2021/2022**

Both sites will be having significant works over the summer to develop the provision to provide a stimulating, meaningful environment that the learners need to enhance their experience at Lime Academy Hornbeam.

The development works have been split into phases as we cannot progress through the phases until the previous phase has been completed.

**Phase 1 - Both sites**

- All roofing to be replaced to prevent leaking to ensure that the building is warm and dry for the learners
- All lights will be replaced with energy efficient lighting
- Boiler repairs

**Phase 1 – Brookfield House**

- New roof + Lighting
- Initial development of the quad to remove existing raised beds to provide a flat surface for students to access
- Development of outdoor area by Early Years to provide a wet pour and grass area for learners to access
- Replacement of playground fencing
- Removal of decommissioned porta-cabin and installation of new playground perimeter fence
- Installation of hoists

**Phase 1 – William Morris**

- New roof + Lighting
- Primary classrooms to be painted, equipped, decorated and the installation of electrics
- Primary outdoor area to be developed – Soft pour with equipment, garden area to be revamped
- Primary house to be painted, equipped and decorated and developed into a life skills area

**Phase 2 – Brookfield House**

- Quad area to be developed creating a sensory trail and water-play area
- New surface to provide a separate playground for the older learners
- Adapted outdoor gym to be installed
- Development of adapted horticulture area

**Phase 2 – William Morris**

- Development of horticulture area
- Change existing windows in Primary provision to provide additional lighting
- Installation of outdoor gym area
- Development of the Muga
