Learning @ BFH – Green Class

This week Green class have been working on their recognition of cause and effect resources. During their ICT lesson they have been undertaking switch work with a variety of items.



They have used a range of switches to activate engaging resources, such as a bubble machine, a vibrating cushion, a foot spa, a spinner, as well as talking tiles with music recorded on them. It was great to identify the students motivating items to work with, and see their reaction once they pressed the switch to gain the resource.



The students have also been working on personalised PE activities aimed at developing their physical abilities. This includes some students practicing their walking, and strengthening their leg and core muscles. Some pupils have been focused on stepping up and over, while others have been concentrating on developing their arm control,

reach and grip.

This half terms topic of “Incredible Me” has been enjoyed by all, allowing students to create art work focused on the students’ areas that are important to them, stated on their EHCP.
