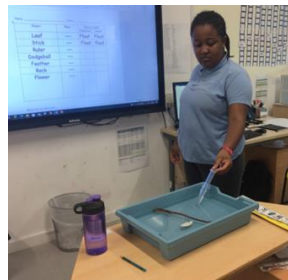

Learning @ WM – Terry Fox Class

The class conducted an investigation to study which items sink or float. Each student was tasked with finding an item to test. After learning about the concept of density and other variables which affect floatation, the students made predictions for which items would sink or float before testing them out in a container of water.



Fox class made a display to honour the late Queen Elizabeth. They made collages out of newspaper clippings showing her at various stages of her life. It was a great activity to help appreciate her amazing life and the contributions she has made.
