Dear Parents and Carers,

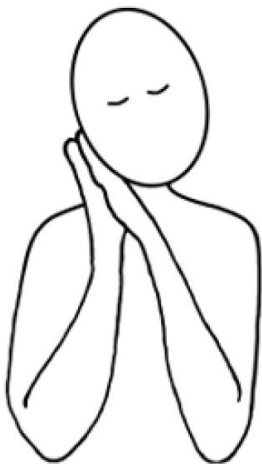
As Half term approaches, we are very much looking forward to the summer term.

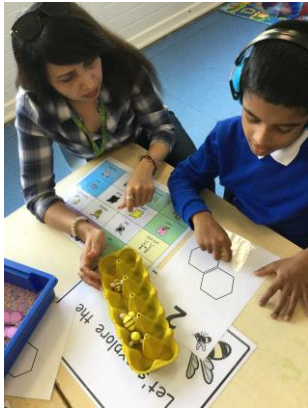

Welcome to this edition of [Go Live Greetings](#). Last month, I wrote about a few of the creative learning projects we offer for SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) young people. You may know that we also hosted the very first **relaxed performance** in the West End at *Shrek the Musical* in May 2012. Relaxed performances provide a special opportunity for families with children with SEND to enjoy a performance where slight adjustments are made to the show's sound and lighting and normal rules of theatre etiquette don't apply. Since 2012, we've hosted 10 additional West End relaxed performances.

I'm thrilled to say we are offering our next relaxed performance at ***Wicked* on Thursday, 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023 at 1.30pm at the Apollo Victoria Theatre.**



Our aim is to offer a supportive, understanding and welcoming atmosphere for young people with autism, learning disabilities or other sensory and communication needs, who would benefit from a more relaxed environment. We work with the production staff to make the necessary adjustments, as well speak beforehand with the theatre staff, cast members and production team on what to expect at these performances. Importantly we buy out the whole performance, so we can reduce the ticket prices for these families. Tickets for adults and young people are **£7.50 - £20**.
