


Message from the Head teacher:

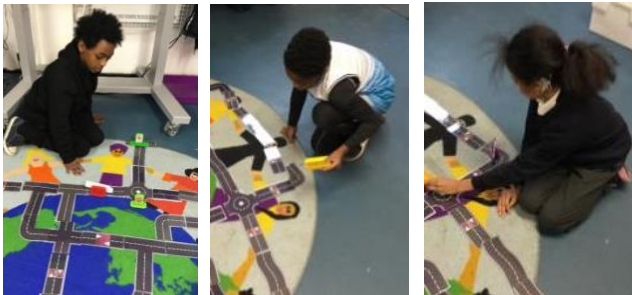
