I would like to take this opportunity to thank all parents and carers for their support this academic year.



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## Learning @ BH - Orange Class

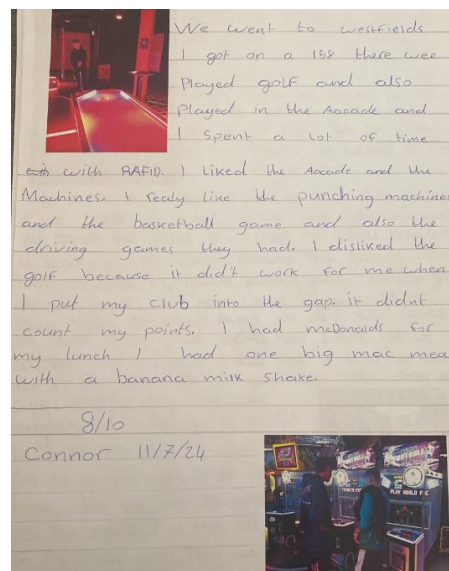
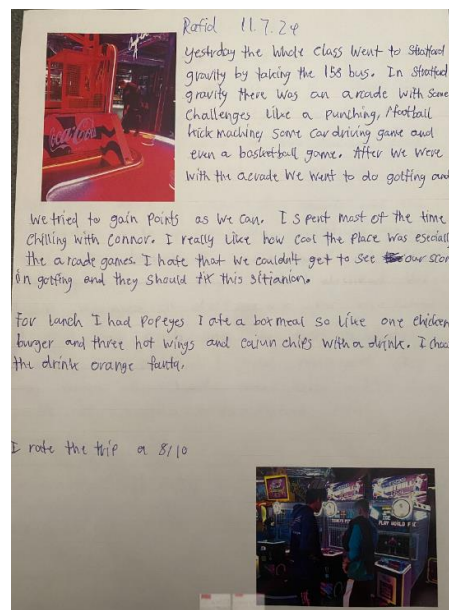
